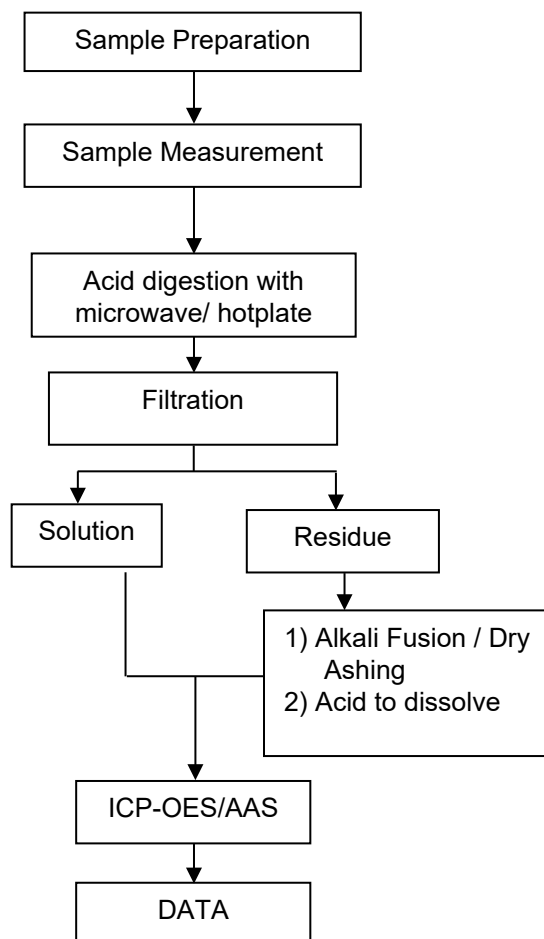

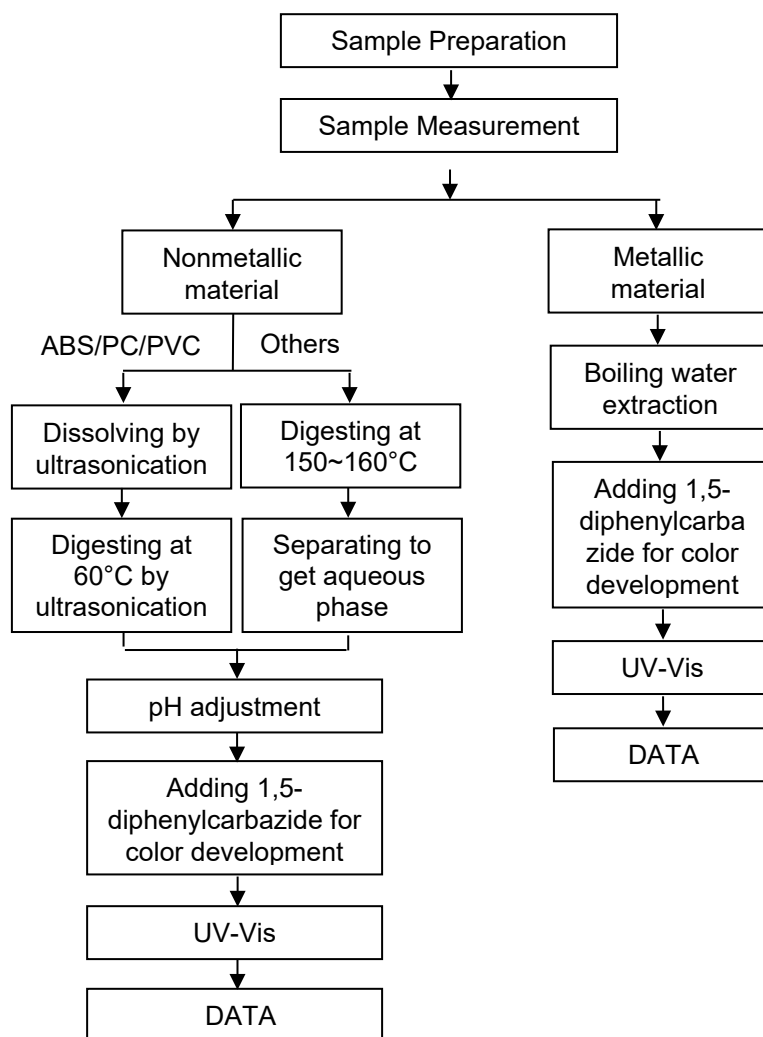

Elements Testing Flow Chart

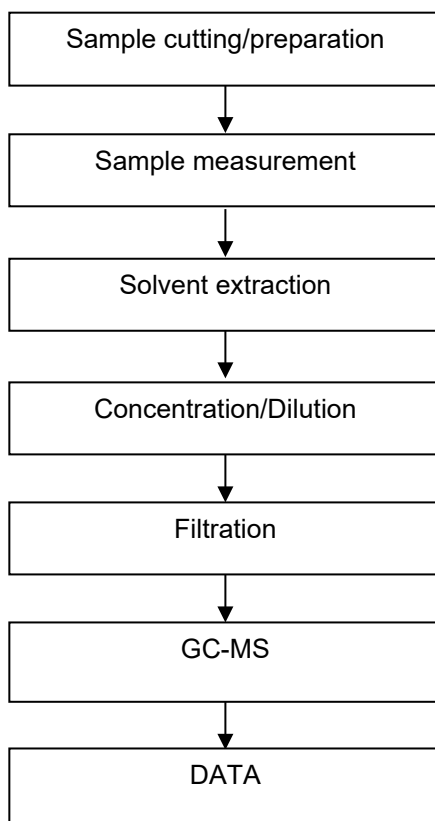
These samples were dissolved totally by pre-conditioning method according to below flow chart.

PBB/PBDE/Phthalates Testing Flow Chart



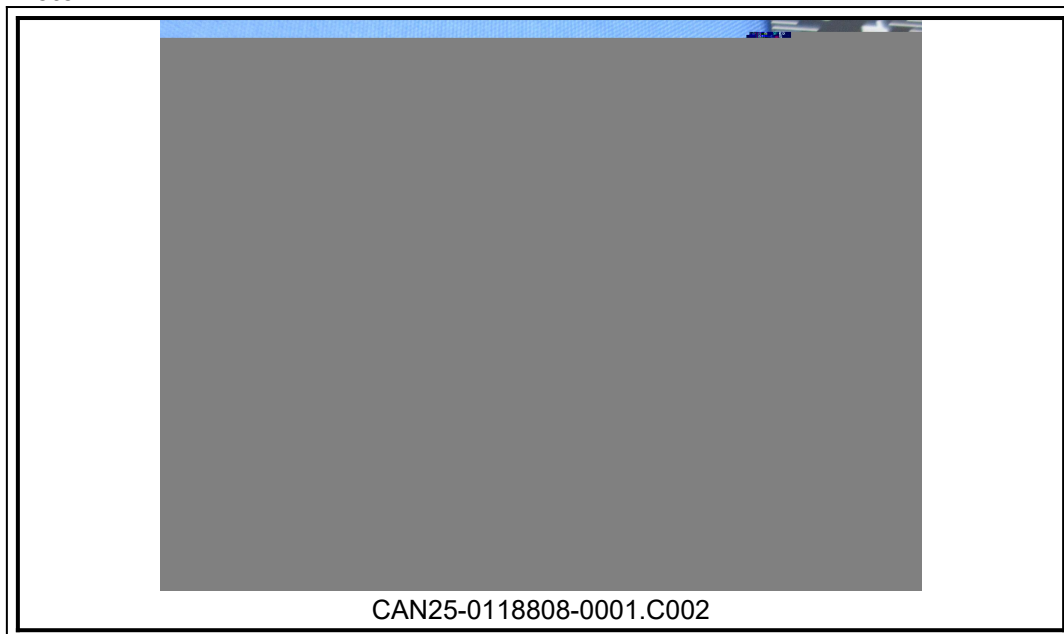
